We must give to the bible attention with intention and it is intention that will necessitate attention. We believe a knowledge of the bible without a college course is more valuable than a college course without the bible.

Instructions;--

We have started the 3<sup>rd</sup> batch with 16 students. two students were dropped for their personal reason. 14 students have been used to attending the classes regularly. 14 students from various parts of the A.P and T.N used to attending bible classes four days in week.

So, these three gospels may be viewed together. Master this out line; Matthew \_presents Jesus as king \_written primarily for the Jew. He is son of David He is royal genealogy is given in the chapter. Mark;;-- mark depicts Jesus as servant —A merciful servant, there is no genealogy. More miracles are found here than in any other gospel., Luke :-- sets forth Jesus as perfect man, son of man. John::-- portrays Jesus as the son of God written to who will beliee with the purpose of leading men to Christ (Jn20;31) Study of Ephesian, Homiletics, means of Grace--- Papers taken by Rev.Ude., Beatitude, little study of Greek and Hebrew, History of the Martin Luther, Book of Concordia, Fellowship, Justification, 10 basic principles of bible interpretation, the will of God--- papers taken by Rev.David Koenig., Old Testament Review—Pastor K.Ashirvaeham, Martin Luther's Small Catechism,--- Rev.T.Sampath, Creed and Music classes ... Rev. V. Rajamani.

Teaching methods.

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We used three basic methods. Students preparation method.;---

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This real work by students. We might assign sections we tell each one to read the section assigned study the scriptures, and then given in his words, give each one s specific to speak.

Class discussion.;-

We might hand out discussion topics for the following week. First we give a chance to select their own topic out of the bible for example they may select a Coconut Tree, next time in the. lesson on what is the Gospel ? why four gospel ? what is the one purpose of four gospel ? why called synoptic gospels?

What is main two teachings of the Bible? A quick answer is always best answer.

Lecture

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We have established a good rapport our class students will fell free to interrupt the lessons when they

have questions.

We have double purpose in each lesson \_to present the book it its proper relation to the entire scope of the bible and bring out one grand truth, one practical lesson from each book .we may cover several sub themes .but keep coming back to the main lesson. The closing portion of our lesson is of prime importance.

Our desire present Christ in a winning way our constant dependence on prayer, and our utter reliance on the guidance of the Holy Spirit.

Prayer Time.—

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Begin each classes session with prayer. We are commanded to pray without ceasing (1<sup>st</sup> Tes5;17) time of prayer in class, we must completely sold on its necessity our self. We might make it a standard practice to ask the Lord daily His guidance as we lead our students. Ask him to give us a love and understanding of them that is like unto His love and understanding prepare our lesson with prayer receiving an important part in our consideration.

As we come to class have an attitude that shows our complete dependence upon the Holy Spirit to guide our thoughts and words. Before we teach, as that God will lead us. Encourage the students but do not force participation.

Pastor Ude, Pastor Koenig, and pastor K.Ashirvadham used visual aids projected aids, chalkboard, diagrams and charts and maps. Use the visual aids that best illustrates a particular lesson.

Pastor Ude in his many classes preview the film before class. The film project should be used either to introduce the or to summarize that which has been taught.

Maps.—

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Maps are indispensable to man. He is continually making and using maps. Maps helps the students to visualize and localize important geographical areas.

Pastor Ude and Pastor Koenig use maps opportune moment. The map should be used. Supply information or data. a map of Paul's journeys would be helpful to show the spread of Christianity throughout the world. We use a variety of methods to impress these great truths upon the minds of our MLBS students we can get across one main idea each lesson \_and only one.

Give class a picture the whole of God's pattern, second preparing each lesson a week advance constantly bring the eternal theme of each book.

Examinations

Jesus knows the ability and weakness of each student, our written examinations oral test and assignment work are some for everyone. We have been conducting monthly unit test on Mann Luther's Small Catechism, four gospels, O.T.review, we have been conducting written examination and oral test three months ones the students of MLBS are encouraged to participate the gospel team service and also Sunday worship services under one BELC pastor.

We convey our thanks to our beloved Missionaries and Board of our CLC trustee our beloved missionaries spend more times in teaching and preaching in the mist of our students and our BELC pastors and believers. They both encourage us in several ways. They both used their full efforts to our

mission work. They both defined and explained each and every word, we learn the true bible teachings, the Lutheran teachings through them and we attained knowledge about our CLC doctrines.

Rules to be observed.

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Right relationship with tutor must be maintained at all times there must be a constant study of His word. We are not only taught them, but we make them demonstration and practical.

To bring men to saving knowledge of Jesus Christ we depended entirely upon the power of God through His Holy Spirit wants to gain more souls.

We don's wants be merely listeners to God's word, but put the Gospel in to practice Conclusion;
